<u>Core Books and Songs:</u> Children's core books/songs and rhymes have been re-planned, if you would like a copy of this please ask your key worker at any time, copies are also available in the entrance area and on our webpage. Parents are welcome to stay at preschool and read with their children at any time. We also have book-sacks and music bags available in our lending library that can be borrowed at any time.

Changing Bags and Spare Clothes: Please can parents make sure that children have changing bags with spare clothes, wipes and nappies as required. At Tickton pre-school we do a large amount of water play, clay, sand, mud play and gardening. We do provide all-in-one suits, but it is best for children to be dressed in old clothes/shoes that can be easily washed and don't cause upset if dirty. Just a reminder for all parents to please bring winter coats each day too, winter is fast approaching and children need to access the outdoor area in all weathers.

<u>Profiles:</u> Please feel free to take your child's profile home at any time. You will also be receiving a summative assessment shortly (a summary of your child's development in December) – if you have any questions regarding this record your key person is happy to discuss at any point (face to face or via the telephone if this is more convenient). We promote parent meetings and are happy to meet at any time to discuss any aspect of preschool life. We have also created 'play with numbers' and 'play with letters' packs that parents can borrow at any time (please ask your key worker).

We are collecting Jam Jars with lids for future projects - please help us in this task.
